



WHAT IS THE ACCESS TO JUSTICE HUB?

The Access to Justice Hub is an online repository of service providers and programs designed to make it easier for survivors to access justice.

WHAT WILL BE ON THE HUB?

The hub will contain information about programs and organizations that can help survivors to access services like housing, medical care, legal advice, and financial support. There will also be links to SASC resources for survivors such as mental health exercises and information.

WHAT WILL THE HUB LOOK LIKE?

At first launch, it will look like a directory of programs that users can filter by age, language, financial requirements, and other categories. We will continue to change the hub overtime to ensure it is in the best possible format. As we gauge the interest of organizations, we plan to add more interactive elements such as community bulletin boards.

WHY JOIN THE HUB?

Survivors face barriers when accessing justice due to a lack of accessible information. This hub is part of the solution to that problem.
